This Service Campaign has been initiated because DCAG has determined that on the affected vehicles (see VIN range below) the rubber boot on the rack and pinion may have been deformed during assembly. Dealers are to check the boots and replace the rack and pinion if necessary.

Please review the Effective Serial Number chart located below and if necessary repair the subject vehicles during the vehicle's next service.

Prior to performing this Service Campaign:

- Please check VMI to insure the vehicle is involved and to determine if the vehicle has been previously repaired.
- Please review the entire Service Campaign bulletin.

Procedure

- 1. Place vehicle on lift (refer to WIS: AR00.60-P-1000V).
- 2. Remove center (lower) engine compartment panel.
- 3. Visually check both rack-and-pinion steering boots for damage:
- If both boots are normal/undamaged (Figure 1), reinstall center engine compartment panel. No further work is necessary; campaign is complete.

- If one or both bellows is/are deformed as shown (Figures 2, 3), proceed to next step.
- 4. Replace rack-and-pinion steering assembly (refer to WIS: AR46.20-P-0600V).

Note (applies to the above WIS instructions):

- Step 10: **Do not** rotate tires.
- Step 24: Does not apply to this campaign,
 Do not perform.


